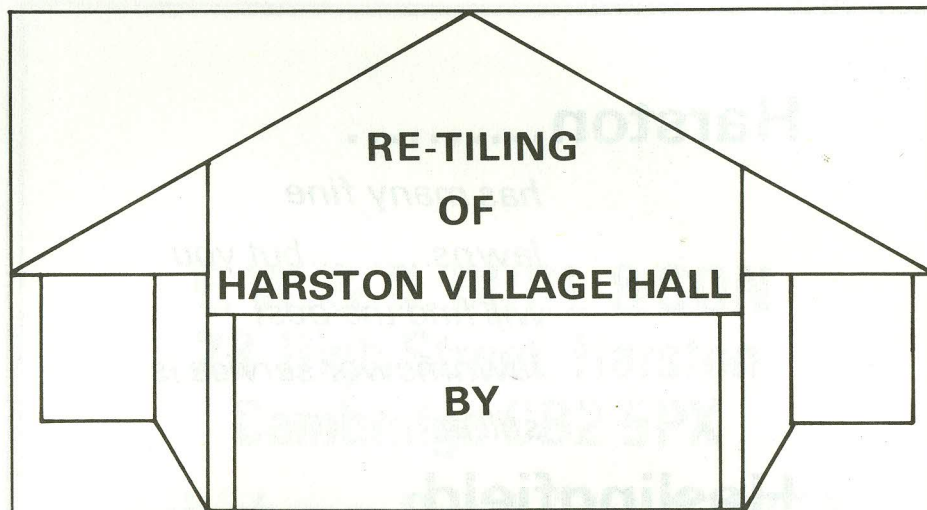

HARSTON VILLAGE HALL

The Hall was officially opened on Friday 2nd November, 1923 by the late Sir William Graham Greene, whose leadership and enthusiasm had inspired all sections of the community to great efforts in order to achieve a building "worthy of the village of Harston". Sir Graham closed by saying that he "felt that the opening of the Hall was a point in the history of the village, and of rural England generally" and he seriously trusted that the event would be a great one in their time. Members of the Executive Committee also on the platform were: Dr W. J. Young, Mrs Young, Mr G. Royston, Miss Helen Greene and Mr W. Fisher.

A Declaration of Trust was made on 27th November 1933 by Sir William Graham Greene, Mr T. Harold Smith and Dr W. J. Young, these Trustees holding in fee simple the property, furniture and effects.

The piece of land upon which the Hall was situated (frontage 100 feet, depth 525 feet) was vested in the Official Trustee of Charity Lands on 27th July 1937.

In October 1946 an application made to the Board of Charity Commissioners to have the Hall vested in them, was, after due communication to the Parish Council of Harston, approved and established. It was sealed on 18th April 1947. In accordance with the Scheme, the Council of Management now consists of "14 competent persons", being 7 Elected Members and 7 Representative Members (of Village Organisations).

At this time Dr Young was unable to continue as a Trustee because of ill-health and his place was taken by the Rev. Leonard Askham, Vicar of Harston 1946-1954 who was entitled to hold office for life; we are very happy to welcome him as speaker at the service on Sunday 28th October to start the Jubilee Celebrations.

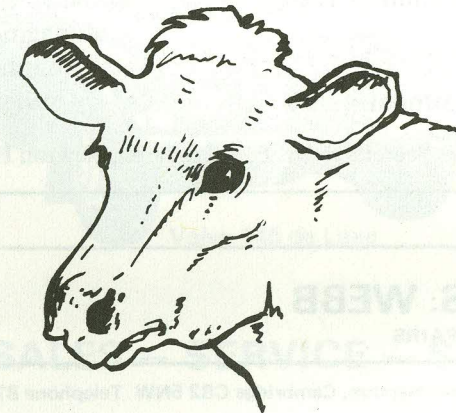

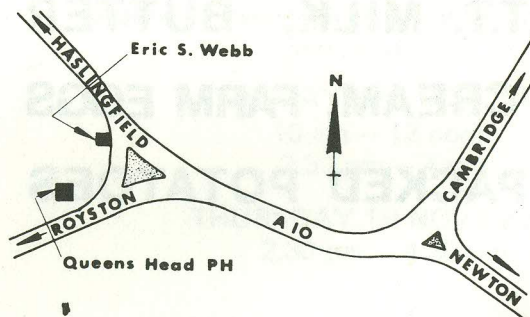
